Is There a limited number of clients can view images I tried my iPhone reached maximum number of users	25 users can view the session at a time for now.
with the new capture one for ipads we can use all the specs of the capture one for the pc as well?	Almost! There are still some differences between the two versions of the app. What feature are you interested in?
Question: I have to shoot portraits for a graduating class can I easily create separate links per student within minutes of each other?	Sure thing! You can put images into various collections – Albums or Smart Albums – and share them altogether.
Is there a way to keep the comments event after closing or stoping the live share?	I'm afraid it cannot be saved for now, but this is something we would look into. Thanks for the feature request!
What is the most you can add?	For a regular session, that's going to be 25 users max.
Can we modify the max number ourselves or is that a server setting	That's a server setting. We'll look into maximizing the number of available users.

how many live camera can use at the same time for this live shoot? let say you are work in team with more than 1 camera	The number of cameras is not limited, if you shoot into one Live collection.
can you shoot from the camera wireless also?	Yes, that works too! Only if you have a camera that is supported for tethering wirelessly in Capture One.
is capture 1 live shoot support collaboration online with other photographer?	For now, this is quite tricky to implement. But you can work around this by having your Capture folder on the same network drive/server, so that the feed comes up from two devices concurrently.
Can client download images the same day?	You cannot download images off the Live session, but you can surely share them yourself.
Is there a way to keep the comments even after stopping the live share?	No, not really. But we'll look into this as a feature request.
does the images remain on the phone after the shoot is over Looking to buy an apple ipad for tethering, any recommendations .? Gop with the apple pro?	No, only if the session is still being shared by the photographer and you have the link to access it. These iPads are supported with Capture One for iPad: iPad Pro third generation and more recent iPad eighth generation and more recent iPad mini sixth generation and more recent iPad Air fourth generation and more recent So, you can look into getting one of these. do most people use the iPad Pro?
can we also see the metadata from this live shoot preview? like the ISO, shutter speed and aperture?	Not currently, but you could add a text overlay generated with Tokens
What is the workflow for multiple clients on a job as far as your folders and naming and making qr codes for each?	You could share various collections with them at the same time, so you can also use different QR codes.
where does the QR code come from	It's coming from the Google Chrome sharing button in the address bar where the link is opened. You can use any other service to convert your link to a QR code.
is this live preview photo is original quality or is compressed? because i trying to zoom, but it like not high quality	That's a preview, which is not a full resolution image.
So, on my phone I can download a 960x1440 image. Can the photographer disable this? Because, yes it is lowres, but for sure it will be on the socials before the client (company) will get the retouched ones.	There's not a way to disable this, as the image would still have to be cached somewhere on your phone. But remember, you can add a watermark to prevent usage.
