Hi Olaf, yeah, the iPad screen can't be calibrated, that's true, even though the colors of iPad match the apple screens a lot. Yes! Long tap on an image in the browser

Hi, Can you use the ipad to mirror a session on capture one pro running on a separate mac?	Hi Jordan, Capture One for desktop and the one for iPad are separate apps, so yeah, mirroring is not possible, but check what David is saying about Capture One Live. Might be an option for you.
And is it right, that Live on lpad comes with no restrictions (e. g. 1 month shown for the client instead of 24 hours)? Hi David, If I export a full resolution Raw file as a jpeg, then email it to myself and save the image in the Photos app, it's fine, the size is correct. If I export the same jpeg as a web optimised 2048 px image, email it to myself then save it in the Photos app, it shows as a 1080 x 720 px (270k) which is the Instagram size. If I now export the same image yet again as a web optimised 2048 px image then share it via the 'Save to Files option' it saves as a 2048 px (2.1 meg)image the way it should export. Any ideas David? You can add custom vignetting in the Desktop version: https://support.captureone.com/hc/en-us/articles/360002605837-Applying-a-vignette Ok, would be great. Time ago I tried, but could not move the center point, wast fixed around the center. But if this is working than I retry it. :-)
