can we do a non-centered vignette without using a circular mask?	Thanks. I'll do that! Hi Rafael! In order to get a non-centered vignette, you will need the radial mask. You can check this tutorial: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=8Kp_JbslsQ8
How can we create an edit short cut that makes unconstrained the default opening parameter for crop tool instead of original?	Hey! I guess you can try the following: If you wish the crop ratio to be global instead, this can be set in Preferences > Crop > Behavior > Use global aspect ratio. And choose the one you wish to have a default one, like Unconstrained. I just tried it, it works for unconstrained but not for crop outside image!? It might be not saved as a part of Crop settings, but that would be a nice addition to have.
How do you set 'unconstrained' as default?	If you wish the crop ratio to be global instead, this can be set in Preferences > Crop > Behavior > Use global aspect ratio and make sure it is Unconstrained.
Regarding crop, using my Fujifilm X camera in an aspect ratio other than 3:2, why doesn't Capture One display that ratio with the RAW photos?	Hi Leon, we import a "clean" RAW, so any adjustments done in-camera, like a specific crop, would be discarded. So all the time and effort I'm spending getting my cropping in camera right, Capture One discards. I believe CO is the only DAW that discards this information. Very unfortunate. True that. Might be something we can add in future updates. This idea has been requested to CO for years. No changes though. I guess it couldn't hurt to bring it up again. Is there any way to get Capture One to prefer big round numbers? I'm very anal and spend huge amounts of time moving between (for instance) 1001 and 999 to finally get 1000 pixels as one dimension. (Or to get 1.0 or .5 or whatever in sliders. It wears me out!	Hi Jonathan! If you are cropping to specific outputs, then use the method that David showed in the broadcast.
Is there some place where Capture One will display the size of the image in megapixels?	Currently, Capture One doesn't display that – only the pixel resolution like 1280x720 in the Metadata tool.
