Question	Answer
Can I convert a luma constraint into an editable mask?	Hi Paul! You can use the eraser in a Luma mask. If you want to modify it by drawing (adding more area of the image to the mask) you would need to rasterize it first: right-click on the mask > Rasterize
Can you pls repeat, how do you turn on the grayscale in the mask

You can see if its enabled in top menu > Layer > Mask Visibility. if I wanted to get rid of that tiny tab hanging off the bird's beak, is there a way to do that? perhaps you could back track later...	Hi Linny! It would be possible by using either a clone mask or a heal mask. They are automatically created when selecting these kind of brushes. If you mean adjusting exposure/brightness in a mask, it is possible (adjustment masks) Or do you mean creating a mask from exposure/brightness values? It is possible to create a mask using the Luma Range, David will talk about it later in any case.
is there restriction on the version of capture one for the new functions? i have a perpetual license at the momnet and i am not sure what features i am receiving - thank you!	Hi Iris! Our license model changed in February, so it will all depend on when you purchased your perpetual license. I took several photos in a Capitol rotunda of some paintings. How can I remove some of the glare made by the lighting which is too bright in portions of the painting?	Hi Terry! If you need to adjust exposure/highlights in some specific areas of your images, you could use either the High Dynamic Range tool which works really well, or create a Luma Mask, David will explain how to create them later.

Is there a short cut key to quickly switch between adding and erasing brushes on the mask	Hi Koko! There are shortcuts for drawing/erasing indeed: E > Erase B > Draw mask These are the default shortcuts, you can custom them from Edit > Edit Keyboard Shortcuts

<p>Can I select only the shadows and ad noise that only affects shadows?</p>	<p>Hi David! It is possible to create a mask using the Luma Range and select only the shadows. You will be able to correct/adjust Noise Reduction (only Luminance and Details sliders), but not add more. Thanks Marian, would be great on futures versions of capture one be able to control where to ad more noise, sometimes client like a film look and be able to control where ad more noise would be a nice touch</p>
<p>Is it possible to synchronize the Luma Range to different layers</p>	<p>Hi Ralph! Do you mean the exact same Luma Range to different layers? As you create the Luma Range based on a specific layer, it will be different for each of them. You'll need to set up the Luma Range from scratch if you apply it in a new/different layer. But as David is explaining now, you can create a brush based on Luma Range values.</p>
<p>Just so I am clear, on the grayscale mask, white reveals and black conceals, so any adjustment takes place wherever it is white.</p>	<p>Hi James! You're right :)</p>
<p>how to change a shade color easily?</p>	<p>Hi Jerome! As we are talking about masking in this webinar, David is about to explain how to create layers from a color range selection.
